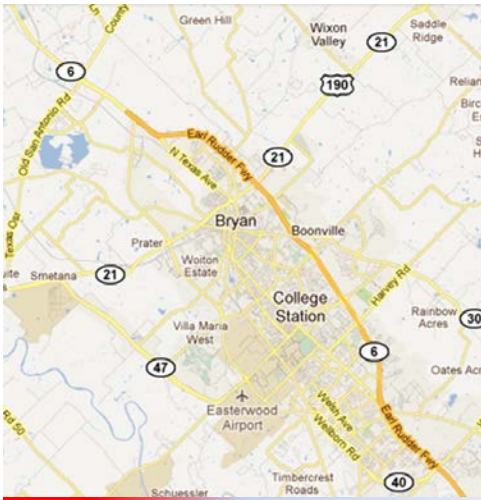
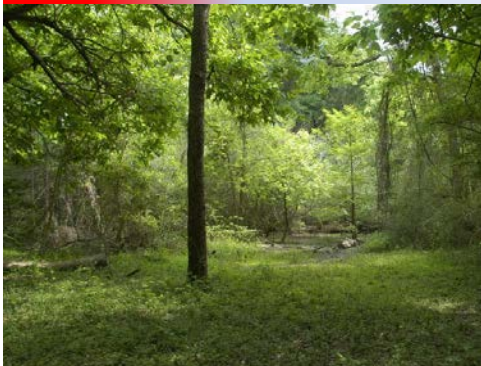


TX-TF1 REQUESTED FOR SEARCH OPERATIONS IN BRAZOS COUNTY



On the early morning of April 18, 2011, Texas Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) received a call from City of College Station officials requesting assistance. A College Station resident was reported missing and the city required assistance with the search. City officials requested assistance with search management as well as three canine teams.



At 6:30 am on April 18, TX-TF1 deployed a search management team and canines to Brazos County. The team met with local emergency management officials to work in coordination with local responders. At 7:35 am, the local jurisdiction informed TDEM that the missing resident had been located and was in good condition. The TX-TF1 search management team demobilized a short time later and all personnel returned to College Station the afternoon of April 18.
